

AIRBUS A318/319/320/321 (CFM 56) General Familiarization - Theoretical EASA Part-66 C Type Training Course

Course duration: 35 working hours (6 days)

School hours are from Monday to Friday with a daily schedule from 08:30 – 16:00 h.

In order to receive a Certificate of Recognition (COR), a minimum participation time of 90% of the training hours is required.

Description:

The aim of training is to get a general knowledge about aircraft, engines and systems.

Objectives:

Acquire knowledge about general layout of the aircraft's major systems and general layout and characteristics of the power plant. Identify aircraft manuals.

Acquire general knowledge about maintenance practices important to the airframe, its systems and power plant, special tooling and test equipment used with the aircraft, safety precautions related to the airframe, its systems and power plant

After completion of the course and passed examination the student will receive a Certificate of Recognition (COR).
