

## **STANDARD PRACTICES**

**Course Duration:** 3 days (22 working hours)

School hours are from Monday to Friday with a daily schedule from 08:30 – 16:00 h.

### **Description:**

The training will be conducted in the classroom and in the maintenance facilities. The student will gain basic knowledge and skills necessary to achieve high standards for job preparations and controlling of prepared job in maintenance and modifications on aircraft, in accordance with manufacturer's documentation (ESPM, ASM, AMM, CMM).

### **Objectives:**

Gain knowledge and skills in usage of AMM, ESPM, SRM.

Achieve high standards in repair of ERI, ZIM & Structure systems on the aircraft.

Gain essential knowledge in inspection.

Gain skills in usage of Aircraft Manuals.

After completion of the course the student will receive a Certificate of Recognition (COR).
